Thank you for keeping us in your prayers. We have had some tough decisions to make lately and God is leading us and giving us wisdom. One decision is where to deliver the new baby who is due in late June. Beth wants to stay in St. Vincent so our next child, a boy, will be born here on the mission field. Beth is doing well so far and receiving positive check-ups with her doctor. Lord willing, our next update letter will contain news of a new healthy baby boy.

We have seen good results from the out-door meetings held in February on the windward side of the island. The area we were in is called South Rivers. The pastor there reports increased attendance at his church and a revived spirit among the believers. The community is still being affected by the gospel meetings held there. We plan to hold out door meetings at our church in Kingstown Park. We are praying about holding the meetings in July. We have enough space to hold the meetings beside the building we are renting for church. Our building is centrally located at a busy intersection so we already have a prime location for evangelistic out-door meetings. We hope to reach out to those who have not accepted an invitation to come hear the gospel. With the size of the sound system we plan on using, no one will have a choice but to listen to the gospel! Please pray with us for these meetings. We desire to reach out with the good news to those who desperately need it.

We also plan to have another baptism service in July. Our first baptism service was in January. Since then we have seen God save a number of people. Please pray for the new believers as they undergo discipleship. We are praying for the new believers to grow into mature believers who will be able to train others also.



Another prayer request is for our future housing. We must leave our current house later this summer. We would like to move close to the Bible College because we spend so much time there. However, housing is very expensive. We looked at a two bedroom apartment today and they wanted \$1000.00 U.S. per month. The owner said he would give us a big discount. We politely thanked him for his time and walked away. Most likely he would not understand a missionary's budget. Most of a missionary's funds go to the ministry; he lives on what is left over! Please pray for God to lead us to affordable housing for our growing family near the Bible College.
